In the countryside, in a hamlet of 6 houses, in absolute calm, "Chez Josie" is a 5-minute drive from the town of Bannalec and halfway between Lorient (56) and Quimper (29).

"Chez Josie," in Bannalec, "The Land of Broom" in Breton, has no shortage of attractions as it combines the charm and tranquility of the countryside with proximity to the sea.

It's the perfect place to rest, recharge, and discover new horizons.

With its vast natural, historical, and cultural heritage, Brittany is a must-see for hiking lovers!

"Chez Josie" is the starting point for unforgettable walks in a hilly countryside, where the rivers Isole and Ster-Goz peacefully trace their winding paths.

Along shaded paths, you will discover beautiful chapels, fountains, and bread ovens, which are precious witnesses of a preserved heritage.

Feel like fishing? The Isole is a 1st-category river, highly prized by fly fishermen, who consider it their paradise.

Craving the beach? They are just 20 minutes away by car: Moëlan, Guidel-Plage, Clohars-Carnoët, Le Pouldu... Surfing, paddleboarding, canoeing, windsurfing... By the sea, your vacation destination near Quimperlé has everything you need, as water sports are a way of life here.

Arrival and Departures

Your Arrival:

It is fully autonomous if I am unavailable. However, it is very likely that I (or someone else) will be there to welcome you and show you around. The same goes for departures.

The secure key box is located near the gate next to the mailbox.

In this box, you will find 2 keys:

- Veranda door
- House door

I will give you the code to the secure key box shortly before your arrival, via SMS. Don't forget to scramble the code.

Arrivals: after 4:00 PM

Departures: by 10:00 AM

The house Rules

DOORS, LIGHTS

It's always better if they're locked when you're away... It's also great not to leave the lights on unnecessarily :-) ...

02

NO SMOKING

This house is completely "NON-smoking."
However, the garden is spacious... and there are ashtrays.
Please note that French law allows this measure in vacation rentals.

03

NOISE NUISANCE

Please limit noise after 11 p.m. No parties or gatherings in the house or garden, please.

04

OUR ANIMAL FRIENDS

Our animal friends are not allowed during vacations at Josie's (unfenced property and proximity to farm animals, thank you for your understanding).

05

TOWELS / FURNITURE / DISHWARE

Towels and kitchen linen are provided in sufficient quantities. The linen is not intended to be taken outside the house. For the beach, please use your personal towels.

Please do not use more linen than planned for your stay (some closets are "private", and others will arrive after you!)

Please do not move the furniture or remove the rugs.

UNREGISTERED GUESTS

Unregistered guests are not allowed to sleep or shower at Chez Josie. Guests who are registered with a "profile" that is not their own will be refused.

You may host visitors under reasonable conditions and on an exceptional basis.

Before your Departure

PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

Please make sure you haven't forgotten anything :-) And don't take ours either :-)

OTHER TRAVELERS ARE COMING

Please leave the house in the same condition as when you arrived:

Dishes must be clean and put away, just like all the other items in your rental. Empty the dishwasher.

Empty the fridge and freezer.

TRASH AND HOUSEHOLD WASTE

- For your trash in the countryside ...

*A general waste container is available on the side of the road, just behind the garden shed (gray).

*A general waste container (gray) and another for recycling (yellow) are available on the side of the road, at the height of the first hamlet (Kerguillerm).

*Glass should be placed in special containers in the village of Bannalec. We understand that this is not very convenient. If you prefer, you can leave the glass in the bin near the gate, and we will take care of it.

LAUNDRY

You can gather the dirty laundry in the laundry room (towels, sheets, dish towels). It's not mandatory, but it's much appreciated!

IN THE GARDEN

Please gather the sun loungers on the pavement, clean the barbecue grills, and close the parasols!



Important Informations

01

THE CLEANING PROTOCOL

A few hours between each guest...
I strive to keep the house in immaculate condition.
Thank you in advance for respecting this as well.

I commit to a strict cleaning of the spaces after each rental:

- Total ventilation for as long as possible
- · Disinfection of switches, door handles
- Cleaning of windows and mirrors
- · Thorough dusting of furniture
- · Disinfection of kitchen and sanitary areas
- Disinfectant spray on textiles: bed base, mattress, curtains, rugs, sofa, chairs, etc.
- Cleaning of drains and baseboards
- Floors and rugs
- · Professional laundering of bed linens

WASTE, DO A FAVOR FOR OUR PLANET :-)

Nothing obliges you, but I encourage you to be mindful of selective sorting. In the kitchen, you will find :

- · A bin with "black or blue" bags for your household waste
- · A bin with "yellow" bags for all your packaging
- A container for "glass" in the courtyard (see previous page as well)

03

HEATING / WOOD STOVE

The wood stove is not operational in the summer, and the house is extremely well insulated, so you won't need to turn on the heating.

In winter, enjoy a pleasant time by the fire. You can use the wood stored outside. Remember to let it dry for at least 24 hours in the veranda before use. The wood stove will heat the house on its own.

If you feel the need to turn on the heaters, we recommend setting the temperature to 19°C (in line with energy-saving measures).

DAMAGE

Whether intentional or accidental, damages are the responsibility of the tenant. Please notify us of any incidents that occur during your stay so we can make adjustments to better accommodate future guests.

General Conditions

SHORT-TERM RENTALS

01

Our property is intended for "seasonal" rental I am a NON-professional landlord and in no way a hotelier.

The property is reserved exclusively for "Furnished Tourist Accommodation," and the tenant has no right to remain on the premises beyond the reserved stay.

02

USE OF PREMISES

The tenant agrees to adhere to the house rules.

CONDITION OF PREMISES

In accordance with the law, the rented property and its contents are considered to be free of damage upon the tenant's arrival.

03

The tenant must report any defects in writing (via email or SMS) within the first few hours after arrival. Otherwise, the rented property will be deemed to have been received in good condition.

Routine cleaning of the premises is the owner's responsibility. In cases of abnormal use, damage, or exceptional soiling, charges or compensation will apply (+ reporting on booking platforms).

The tenant is responsible for any damage caused by their actions. They are required to have insurance.

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ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

If the tenant does not appear within 24 hours of their arrival date, the booking will be considered canceled, and the owner may dispose of the property and re-rent it. In the case of an abbreviated stay and early departure, please inform us. The owner may then re-rent the property. No refunds will be provided in these two cases.

CANCELLATION BY THE OWNER

In the event of unforeseen circumstances or force majeure, if your rental payment has been made, we will issue a full refund. We will also strive, to the best of our ability, to find alternative accommodation for you.

The ground floor bedding is new (2024) The upstairs bedding is recent and has seen little use The extra bed is new (2024)

The beds are equipped with:
- 1 mattress protector
- 1 protective cover
- 1 fitted sheet / duvet cover / pillows / cushions

The linen is washed in a laundry service using water and non-polluting products (Disinfection during the final rinse cycle for perfect hygiene).

The Garden

The garden was completely redone in October 2023, with the first mowing scheduled for spring 2024!

It's a "garden in progress"! It will evolve over time.

Future plans include: a terrace, gates, resurfacing the courtyard and sidewalk, and adding trees, plants, and a compost bin. A "wildflower meadow" will likely be created at the bottom of the garden to support biodiversity. The use of pesticides is strictly prohibited at Chez Josie.

To start, you will find outside garden furniture (table and chairs), parasols, and sun loungers. There are 2 barbecues (we prefer to use the mobile one to move it away from the plants). Please clean the grates after use. Wood is available for you.

The north side of the house is communal, as is the path next to it. We, the residents, maintain it as best we can. The bank with the large oaks does not belong to the property (otherwise it would be ...green ...)

If you are traveling with an electric car, you will find an electrical outlet in the courtyard!



Heating

You won't need to light a fire in the summer or turn on the heating! For cooler days, you can choose between the heating or the wood stove.

The convectors:

They are located in the main room and the ground floor bedroom. Please maintain a temperature of 19°C.

The wood stove:

Firewood is available for you.

Place a few logs in the veranda 24 hours before use to ensure the wood is dry for burning.


Avoid overloading the fireplace; too much wood will not optimize combustion over time, and the fire will burn too quickly and go out.

Light the fire from the top to prevent excessive smoke at the start.

Adjust the appliance's draft correctly to maximize the burn time. Open all air vents when starting the fire or reloading. Reduce the air vents by half once the fire is lit.

Avoid closing the air vents completely, as this will suffocate and extinguish the fire. Make sure the ashtray is emptied regularly when the appliance is off.

The house, built of stone, is extremely well insulated.

The wooden floor of the upper level allows heat to pass through. Therefore, you will not find any convectors on the upper floor.

The wood stove heats very well. It does the job for both the "living area" and the upper floor.

The bathroom and the bedroom on the ground floor are equipped with electric heaters.


